
## A Note from Mr. Nelson

## Be sure to order a GHS Yearbook!

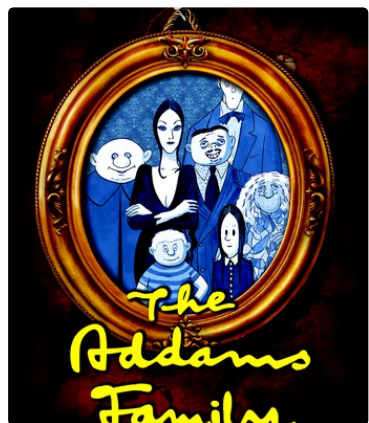
